

Mounting / Demounting of Temples

General


Click Off


- 1. Check opening direction of hinge
- 2. Hold frame at a vertical angle
- 3. Secure hinge firmly with finger
- a) Remove temple with a jolt off the hinge or
 b) lever temple off the hinge
 (again, mind the opening direction of the hinge with both methods)


Click In


- 1. Check opening direction of hinge
- 2. Secure hinge firmly with finger
- 3. Click in the temple with light pressure


Methods














Particularities and Tips

- · Mounting and demounting of temples is strong on purpose and serves the tight hold
- Protection of overexpansion for models SF loop, SF champ, SF kid
- Removing temple with a jolt is important, otherwise the material can be overexpanded
- Older hinges may vary please check opening direction of hinge

Important:

Mounting and demounting of temples are to be executed by trained opticians only not by end-consumers.









Mounting / Demounting of Nosepads (for Opticians)

General

Click Off

- 1. Position frame with nose pad showing downwards
- 2. Press wings down with both thumbs until pad clicks off

Click In Options

A) Without Aid

- 1. Insert pad notch from the bottom with fingernails, press over bolt on the bridge until it clicks in
- B) With mounting tool pad clip (blue)
 - 1. Position pad onto flat surface, wings showing upwards
 - 2. Press tool vertical onto pad and lock it
 - 3. Press tool vertical onto bolt on the bridge and click it in with light pressure
- C) With mounting tool pad clip (black) works without temples only
 - 1. Place pad onto tool, wings showing down
 - 2. Insert black V-notch into hole of tool for fixation
 - 3. Press front with thumb placed onto center of bridge vertical down until pad clicks in

Important

- Nose pads will not be damaged, provided mounting & demounting are handled correctly
- · The strong click in and click off procedure is on purpose and serves a better hold of nose pad
